

Programs

The NRD offers programs for a variety of needs. Below is just a small sampling of NRD programs. For more information on these and many others, visit our web site at www.lpsnrd.org or phone the office at 476-2729.

Community Forestry- Neighborhood associations, villages, towns and cities, on public (non-federal and non-state) lands such as school grounds, parks, cemeteries and street right-of-ways may apply for up to 50% of the cost of plantings of multiple trees by a group.

Conservation Forestry- Provides seedling trees and shrubs for sale in bulk to cooperating landowners.

Farm Pond- To assist landowners in the design and construction of dams for the purposes of: providing water for livestock, wildlife and/or recreation; flood storage; or grade stabilization.

Conservation Easement- A conservation easement preserves and/or enhances farm, wetland, prairie, and woodland, properties District wide.

Fertilizer Flow Meter and Manifold- Allows the even application of anhydrous ammonia, minimizing the leaching of nutrient into the ground water supply and reducing operator costs. NRD cost-sharing: 50% of the cost of the meter and manifold, not to exceed \$1,600.

Well Decommissioning- Applications are accepted year-round, with actual work done between late fall and early spring by a licensed contractor. Program available to any District landowner. NRD cost-sharing: 75%, with landowner cost not to exceed \$150. Cost-sharing is also available for pump removal.

Educational Programs- A variety of educational programs are offered including classroom presentations, outdoor classrooms, and resource materials. All of these help students learn the important role our environment plays in every day life.

Trail Passes- Voluntary annual (\$5) and daily (\$1) trail passes are available on the MoPac East and Oak Creek trails, or by contacting the NRD. All donations are used to maintain existing trails.
