

INVITATION TO BID

The Lower Platte South Natural Resources District invites contractors to submit bids for:

DEADMANS RUN FLOOD REDUCTION PROJECT – PHASE 1 LANCASTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA

The project is for the construction a detention basin that will store high flows diverted from Deadmans Run and slowly release water back into the channel. Includes excavation and hauling of approximately 68,000 CY of earth material, minor fill for embankment, installing a concrete mattress and stilling basin, pipe installation, geoweb soil stabilization, and site amenities. This will require access from right of way, sediment and erosion control, handling of water, and other necessary incidental items.

The project is located in the City of Lincoln southeast of the intersection of 56th and Holdredge Street on property owned by the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District (District) adjacent to Deadmans Run in Lancaster County, Nebraska.

Sealed bids will be received by the District on or before **1:00 pm on Thursday, May 7, 2026**, at the District's office located at 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln, NE, 68521. Envelopes containing the bids shall be sealed and must be accompanied by a bidder's bond in an amount of not less than five percent of the amount bid. The bond shall be made payable to Lower Platte South Natural Resources District as security that the bidder to whom the award is made will enter into a contract to complete the rehab project and furnish the required bonds. Bids will be publically opened and read at the District's office at that time and place.

No bid shall be withdrawn after opening bids without consent of the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District for a period of 45 days after the scheduled time for closing bids. The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.

Plans, Specifications and Bid Documents may be inspected at the office of the LPSNRD, 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln, Nebraska 68521 and will be issued through A&D Technical Supply Planroom (A&D) (<https://plans.adtechsupply.com>) per their distribution polices. Bidding Documents must be obtained from A&D; neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for distributing Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than A&D.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 am central time on Thursday, April 30, 2026, at the District office located at 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln, NE, 68521. An optional opportunity to visit the site directly following the pre-bid conference with District staff will be provided. No access to the site is permitted outside of this scheduled visit.
