**RE:** SCFR Subcommittee May 19<sup>th</sup> LRIP Meeting Minutes

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The SCFR Subcommittee met by Zoom on Tuesday, May 19, 2026. Subcommittee members attending included Larry Ruth, Deborah Eagan, Chuck Hassebrook, Gary Hellerich, Dave Landis, Stephanie Matejka, Anthony Schutz, and Ken Vogel. Members absent included Melissa Baker and Susan Seacrest. Others present were Director Bob Andersen and LPSNRD staff David Potter and Jeremy Gehle. Chair Ruth called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m. The only agenda item was to develop recommendations for the FY27 Budget and the Long-Range Implementation Plan.

The FY26 accomplishments were reviewed and discussed. Potter updated the subcommittee on the completed Feasibility Study led by the City of Lincoln. Potter also shared the next planning study anticipated in the Salt Creek Flood Resiliency Project Program. Although LPSNRD will participate, that next step will need to be determined by the city. Following discussion on the accomplishments, the Natural Resources Benefits of Practices and Programs Table was presented and reviewed, along with the Master Plan goals, desired outcomes and objectives and the LRIP and budget status codes. The subcommittee then discussed the proposed actions and expenditures for FY27 and for FY2028-2031, which concentrated on the existing sinking fund and the need to have funds ready for a potential project.

With no further recommended modifications, additions, or deletions, **it was moved by Vogel, seconded by Landis, and unanimously approved to submit the final FY 2027 Actions and Budget Requests and the FY 2028-2031 Actions and Proposed Expenditures for Salt Creek Flood Resiliency to the Finance and Planning Subcommittee for inclusion in the first draft of the FY27 Budget and LRIP.**

There being no further business, Ruth adjourned the meeting at approximately 5:37 p.m.
