

INVITATION TO BID

The Lower Platte South Natural Resources District invites contractors to submit bids for:

Weeping Water Creek Watershed Site 5K Rehabilitation CASS COUNTY, NEBRASKA

The project consists of the rehabilitation of the existing attenuation berm and stilling basin, consisting of various rocks and embankment fill.

The project is located in Cass County, Nebraska.

Sealed bids will be received by the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District on or before **2:00 p.m., Friday, February 7th, 2025**, at the District's office located at 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln, NE 68521. Envelopes containing the bids shall be sealed and must be accompanied by a certified check or bidder's bond in an amount of not less than five percent of the amount bid. The check or bond shall be made payable to the Treasurer, Lower Platte South Natural Resources District as security that the bidder to whom the award is made will enter into a contract to complete the rehab project and furnish the required bonds. Bids will be publically opened and read at the District's office at that time and place.

No bid shall be withdrawn after opening bids without consent of the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District for a period of 45 days after the scheduled time for closing bids. The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities in the bidding.
