LEGAL NOTICE

The Lower Platte South Natural Resources District will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 21, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the District headquarters, 3125 Portia Street, Lincoln NE, for all persons wishing to testify and/or offer written materials on proposed revisions to the District's Ground Water Rules and Regulations. A general description of the contents of the rules and regulations proposed for adoption are:

- Add/revise definitions for the following terms:
 - o Allocation;
 - o Aquifer Test;
 - o Certified Irrigated Acres;
 - o Domestic Well;
 - o Irrigation Well;
 - o Rolling Allocation;
- Simplify additional information required for water well permits;
- Eliminate details for aquifer test and reasons for granting/denying/cancelling Class 3 water well permits as this requirement is superseded by 600' spacing protection;
- Unify specification for quality/quantity triggers so all triggers must be exceeded for a period of not less than two consecutive years;
- Changes related to the Hydrologically Connected Area (HCA):
 - Revise allowable expansion of irrigated acres in the HCA to account for consideration of allowable depletions under the Lower Platte River Basin Coalition;
 - o Eliminate reference to 20% of historical acres in the HCA as per revised allowable expansion;
- Changes related to the Dwight-Valparaiso-Brainard Special Management Area (DVB SMA):
 - o Establish three-year rolling allocation in DVB SMA;
 - o Eliminate distinction between sprinkler and gravity irrigation for allocation;
 - Specify that allocation will remain in place until the District Board of Directors acts to change it;
 - o Eliminate carryover penalty for existing three-year fixed allocation; and
 - Remove definition of public interest from specific reference to denying a new well permit in DVB SMA;
- Correct various grammatical errors.
