PERSONNEL:

- USDA Service Center Operations The Lancaster and Cass County Service Centers continue to be closed to walk-in customers. Producers may contact their local office to make arrangements for an appointment, or to conduct business by alternate means, such as over the phone, electronically, or by mail.

- Nicole Strand, Soil Conservationist in Lincoln, will be leaving the staff for a promotion. She has accepted the Resource Conservationist position in Osceola. Nicole will continue to be in the Lincoln Field Office until early August. Congratulations Nicole!

LAND TREATMENT:

- The Conservation/Resources Technicians are currently working with contractors and landowners to finish all LPSNRD spring/summer conservation projects. They're also busy surveying/designing dam and terrace projects that will be constructed this spring/summer.
- We continue to take applications for the LPSNRD Land Treatment Program. Applications are due July 1st to ensure consideration under the FY22 operating budget.

PROGRAMS:

- Environmental Quality Incentives Program Staff is finishing up obligating EQIP contracts. The LPSNRD has the following number of contracts:
 - Lancaster County 11 contracts \$232,955
 - Cass County 6 contracts \$195,910
- Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) Secretary Vilsack has announced that USDA will open enrollment in the CRP with higher payment rates, new incentives, and a focus on climate change mitigation. Producers should contact their local Farm Service Agency office for details.
